



BEAVERS BADGE WORK SHEET

For EACH of the FOUR badges, the Beaver may complete a unique task or be part of something that they feel is recognized as part of that Badge's theme. The Beaver is required to do TWO unique items on their own--- while ONE requirement (*) will be done during a BEAVER MEETING. A parent/guardian is to help the Beaver accomplish/fill in/sign off on the 2 unique items ---while a Leader will do so for the things earned at meetings. When the THREE requirements have been filled in on a badge---the Beaver is to bring the sheet in and show a Leader. The Leader will ask the Beaver some fun questions about the things that they did, what they learned, etc. Then, the Leader will sign the final badge "Approval" space and we will present the badge to that Beaver during that meeting's closing ceremony.

This program is to be worked on throughout the full length of the year. There is no order to do them in, no time restrictions and a Beaver does NOT have to try/earn ALL of the badges (if they so desire). It's simply about having fun and trying new things together.
